

Summary of the VICEPHEC23 Diversity Data Survey

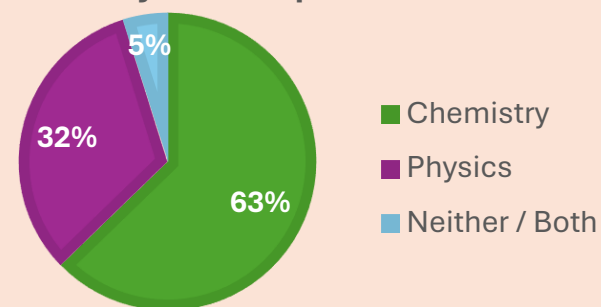

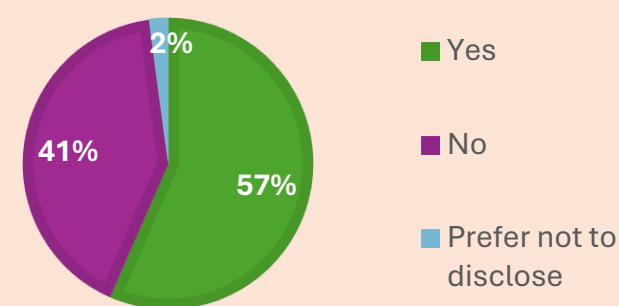
Of the 182 colleagues registered for the conference, 145 completed the survey (80% response rate).

The survey used the Royal Society of Chemistry (RSC) Diversity Data Survey questions. More information from the RSC on the questions can be found on [the RSC website](#).

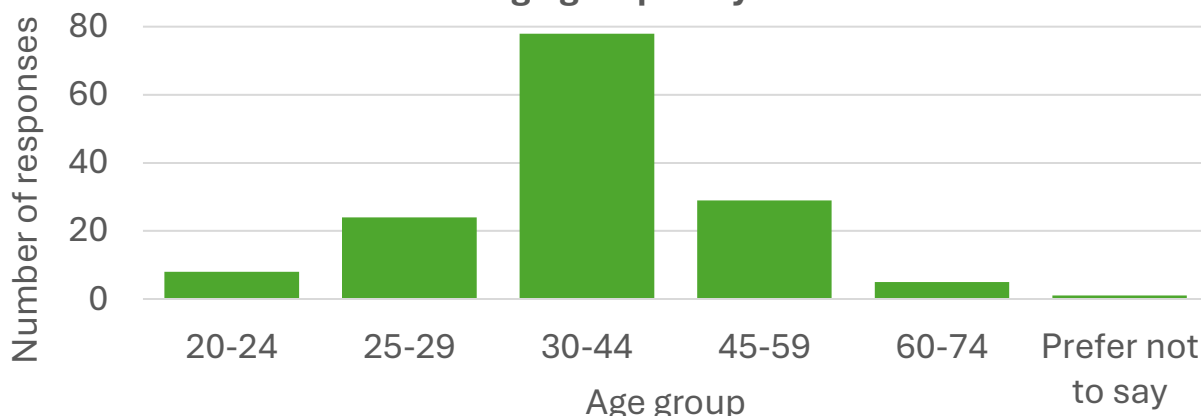
Which science community/communities related to VICEPHEC do you consider yourself part of?



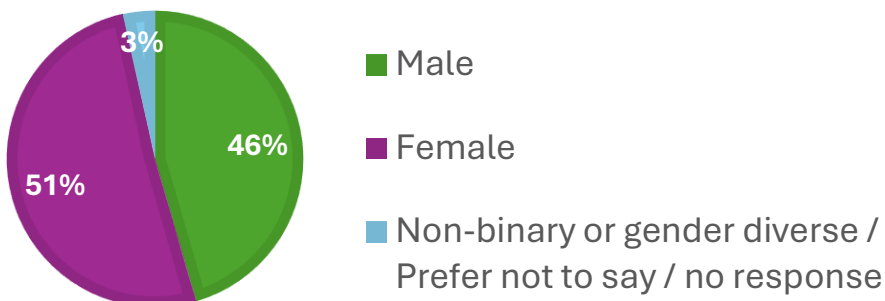
Were you a presenter/author or co-author for any talks, posters or workshops at the VICEPHEC23 conference?



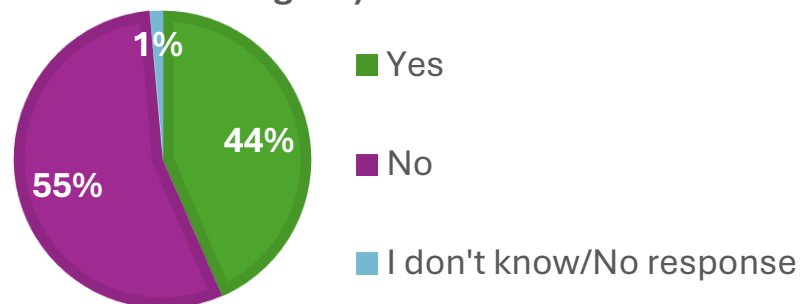
Which age group are you in?



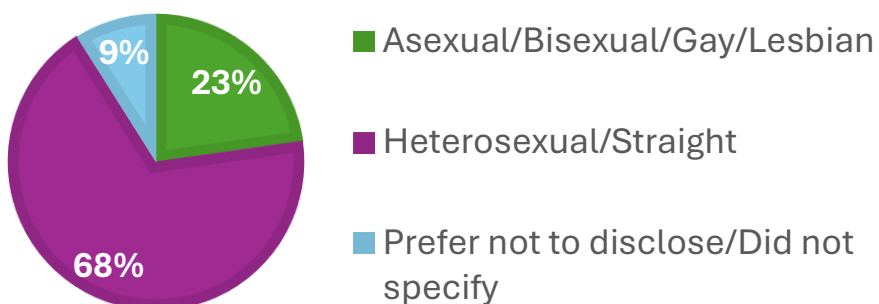
With which gender do you most identify?



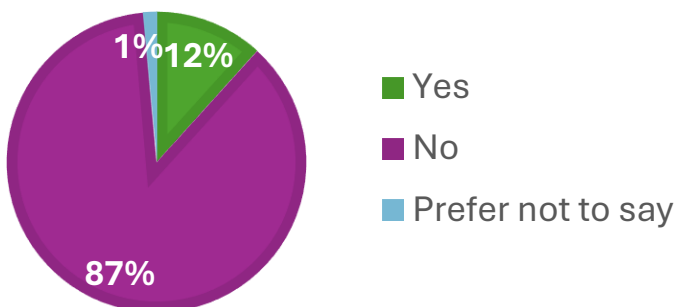
When you were 18, had any of your parents or guardians completed a university degree course or equivalent (e.g., BA, BSc or higher)?
